**End of COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements for Federal  
Employees, Contractors, International Travelers, Head Start  
Educators, and CMS-Certified Facilities**

On May 1st, the White House issued a statement announcing that the Administration will end the COVID-19 vaccine requirements for Federal employees, Federal contractors, and international air travelers at the end of the day on May 11, the same day that the COVID-19 public health emergency ends.

The Biden administration will end its Covid-19 vaccine mandates for federal employees, contractors and international air travelers next week.

The White House said in a statement issued on Monday that those vaccine requirements will end on May 11, the same day the Covid public health emergency expires.

*“While vaccination remains one of the most important tools in advancing the health and safety of employees and promoting the efficiency of workplaces, we are now in a different phase of our response when these measures are no longer necessary”* stated the White House.

HHS and DHS will provide more details on the end of these vaccine requirements in the coming days, the White House said.
